Application date and time: Apply by February 15th (Fri) (except Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday) (On Jan 20th (Sun), Feb 3rd (Sun), and 17th (Sun), application will be accepted.)

Eligibility: Those who meet all the following requirements.

(1) Home, school, or working place, is 500 meters or more away from the nearest station.

(2) When you apply, you must have or are going to buy bicycle, motorized bicycle (up to 50cc), or small motorcycle (up to 125cc).

Where to apply: At the window of each parking lot (See the chart above).

How to know the result of the lottery: The result will be posted at the each bicycle parking lot from February 22nd (Fri). It's also available at the city website (<http://www.ichiharazaidan.or.jp>) or the Ichihara City Foundation for Regional Promotion (<http://ichiharazaidan.or.jp/>).

Note: (1) One application for one person is accepted. One person for one bicycle/motorized bicycle/small motorcycle is accepted. One bicycle/motorized bicycle/small motorcycle for one person is accepted.

Number of Patients Suffering with Rubella Rapidly Increasing

~Subsidizing the cost of vaccination~

The number of patients suffering with rubella is rapidly increasing in the city and prefecture.

Ichihara City will subsidize the cost of rubella vaccination to women who desire to get pregnant and their spouse.

If women caught rubella during pregnancy, an unborn baby could be infected with rubella and born with hearing difficulties and cataract.

Target people are encouraged to take the vaccination.

Period to subsidize the cost of vaccination: August 14, 2018 – March 31, 2019

Target people: Those who meet one of the followings

- (1) Women who desire to get pregnant
- (2) Spouses of (1)
- (3) Spouses of pregnant women

Amount of subsidy: Measles-rubella vaccination for 5,000 yen; Rubella vaccination for 3,000 yen

How to apply: Submit the filled application form available at Hoken Center or the City website with receipt and other needed documents to Hoken Center.

Due date: April 26 (Fri) at the window, and April 30 (Hol) by post.

■Routine Vaccination (free of charge)

Eligibility: [First term] one year old infants.

[Second term] children born from April 2, 2012 to April 1, 2013.

How to get vaccination: Make a reservation at a medical institution. Take a vaccination coupon and mother-child handbook to go to the institution.

■What to be careful about in daily life?

Hand washing

Use soap for hand washing

Coughing etiquette

When coughing, wear a mask, cover mouth and nose with tissue or handkerchief, or cover them with sleeve or inside of jacket.

Prevention of infection from outside

Keep in mind to wear a mask, hand washing, frequent gargle, and face washing. Avoid going to crowded place, and air the room once every hour.
